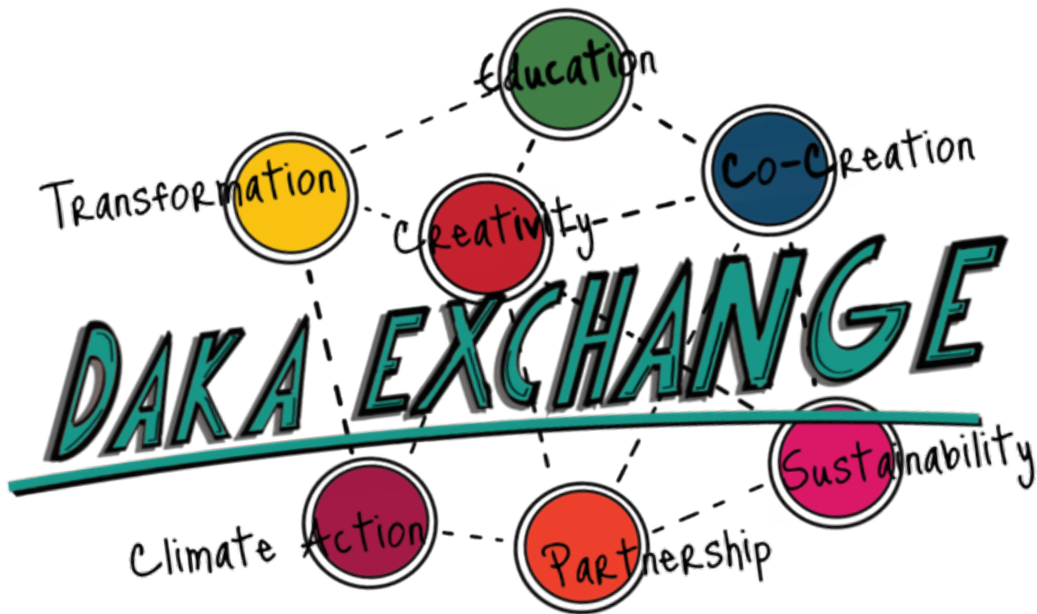

Programme By bringing together eight participants from different organization from each city, we leverage potential for long term collaborations in addressing local issues.

Each part contains workshops, expert meetings and cultural events, as well as excursions. We collaborate with various NGO and are much looking to extend our network.

Who? Professionals and learners from organizations in the field of education, social work and sustainability from Dar es Salaam/Tanzania and Hamburg/Germany with a willingness to learn and work alongside fellows from mixed backgrounds.

Working language is English, though translations will be available.

Application, dates and costs From Hamburg: 1400 Euro if paid by individual, 1.800 Euro if paid by organizations, from Dar es Salaam: 250 Euro. The fee covers the program costs, travel (up to 950 Euro per person) and CO₂-emission compensation, food and lodging in shared rooms. We have limited spaces, so please be in contact as soon as possible.

Deadline for registration: October 8th, 2023. The two parts are connected and application is only possible for both parts.
